- September 30; <u>Luxembourg has made public the interior of its pavilion</u> under construction. By using standard steel materials for the floor, walls and ceiling and through unique assembly and dismantling procedures, the pavilion aims to ensure both quality and the ease of re-using the materials.



EXPO 2025

- October 3; Indonesia introduced on Instagram the mascot of its pavilion, TUMTUM, a friend of Myaku-Myaku. TUMTUM is a character based on the *batik* pattern Tuluntum used in traditional Indonesian clothing. There are three types: green, red and blue. The green TUMTUM symbolises nature, the red TUMTUM symbolises culture and the blue TUMTUM symbolises the future.







- management tables for the execution status of construction and operating costs


3. Upcoming events

- October 13; An event commemorating <u>half a year before the opening</u> of the Expo will be held in Tokyo. It will be streamed live on the official YouTube channel.







From October 9 until the end of the Expo, Expo wrapping will also be applied to the gondolas of the associated Sumaura Ropeway.

<u>5.Q&As</u>

There have been reports that construction of the Integrated Resort (IR) will begin on the land adjacent to the Expo site in Yumeshima, but wasn't the start of construction postponed?

- i. Regarding the IR construction work during the Expo, by postponing the piling work by about two months, the peak of the construction work has been shifted to after the closing of the Expo, and the amount of construction work during the Expo period will be greatly reduced. A liaison and coordination meeting has been newly established by the relevant parties, and it is planned to be implemented so that there will be no adverse impact on the Expo.
- ii. In addition, the]IR operators are currently coordinating to start the preparation work such as the installation of temporary fencing and construction offices. This preparatory work is already included in the IR Zone Development Plan.
