
# Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai, Japan Weekly Report (November 12 - November 18) ~ 145 days to go!~



#### 1. Official Participants

- November 15; <u>Belgium</u> announced that it would name the character of the pavilion of Belgium BELUBELU. On the same day, the Expo Minister Yoshihiko Ito met with Commissioner General Pieter De Crem and Ambassador of Belgium to Japan Antonine Evrard. They confirmed to steadily progress of the Belgium pavilion.

- November 14; <u>Lithuania and Latvia</u> announced the outline of their joint pavilion, the Baltic Pavilion. ### 2. Reports from the past week and plans for the upcoming week


- November 14; Kobukuro, a singer-songwriter duo and Expo Ambassador, performed the <u>official Expo theme song at the Grand Ring</u>. The performance was broadcast on Yomiuri TV/Nippon Television Network as part of the 'Best Hit Kayousai 2024' programme, along with a singing performance by popular artists Aina the End and Number i at the Grand Ring. This was the first time that a music performance had been held on the Expo site.



- November 15; The Association has added the second batch (11 establishments) of <u>detailed</u> <u>information about commercial facilities</u> in the Expo site to the official app EXPO 2025 Visitors. Restaurants and cafes, shops selling local products from Osaka and convenience stores have been newly announced.
