The Expo Bipartisan Diet Members' League

- March 24, the Parliamentarians' League for the Success of EXPO 2025, chaired by Liberal Democratic Party Secretary-General Hiroshi Moriyama held a general meeting. Prime Minister Shigeru Ishiba, Governor Hirofumi Yoshimura of Osaka Prefecture (online), Mayor Hideyuki Yokoyama of the City of Osaka, Chiarman Masakazu Tokura of Keidanren Chairman, as well as members of the Diet and leaders of business federations participated.
- Prime Minister Ishiba stated that the government has a responsibility as the host country and called for the cooperation of all parties involved for the success of the Expo.







1. Introduction of pavilion exhibits

An introduction of official pavilions selected by the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry at its own discretion.

1) Uruguay



- The pavilion is inspired by the beauty and tranquility of nature. A video introducing Uruguay will be projected on a large screen. There will be a space where visitors can read books by Uruguayan authors, an exhibition space for artworks, and a zone introducing Uruguayan traditions including *yerba mate*. Cutting-edge initiatives to solve issues such as sustainable food production and green technologies will also be introduced.
- The National Day is on June 17.

2) Romania



- The concept is a "magic box". Through immersive, interactive exhibitions, the museum showcases the story of Romania's natural bounty and technological innovation and its efforts to create a just and sustainable future. It was designed by students from the Aeon Mink University of Architecture and Urban Arts, which was selected in a competition, and uses reusable building materials.
- On National Day on Thursday, June 26, the George Enescu Philharmonic Orchestra, one of Romania's leading orchestras, will perform online.

3) Qatar



- The design is inspired by the traditional Qatari sailing vessels *dhows* and Japanese craftsmanship. It will shows Qatar's rich maritime heritage and deep ties to the sea, as well as the enduring ties between Qatar and Japan. Inside the pavilion, Qatar's coastal ecosystem, pearl industry and the latest industrial developments are introduced. It demonstrates the country's commitment to taking responsibility for the protection of natural resources and actively investing in intellectual industries.
- The National Day is on July 8.

4) Uzbekistan



- The pavilion expresses the interweaving of Uzbekistan's past and future. The exterior features Uzbek embroidery, ornaments, traditional patterns and other patterns that symbolize Uzbekistan. Inside the pavilion, there will be a moving platform named "Incubator" that introduces visitors to Uzbekistan's efforts to contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals through immersive exhibitions.
- On National Day on Monday, September 1, a music concert will be held. Through the collaboration of traditional and contemporary music, it shows how cultural heritage continues to flourish and evolve in today's world.

■ Jikei Gakuen COM Group Social Contribution Musical "The Door to Tomorrow" *

- Premiered in February 1994. This musical is about students who have learned about the reality of bone marrow transplantation and bone marrow bank projects, thinking about what we can do, planning, producing, and performing in this musical to contribute to society that has been passed down for 30 years.

Iwami Kagura Great Serpent - A trajectory of passion that <u>continues</u>

- In 1970, Iwami Kagura dance troupe's Great Serpent show was unveiled at Japan's first World Expo. The Great Serpent has evolved and will reappear after 55 years, presenting the dance from Shimane Prefecture, known as Iwami in medieval times.

- A four-part performance by the Yatoshima Taiko drum troupe will unleash the power of the earth in Yatoshima, the land of the Japan before it was called Japan.
